INSTALLATION GUIDE

FOR PROPER PARTS® SEAT RAIL BUSHINGS/TRACK GUIDES



1	After removing the seat tracks from the car, remove the forward/backward actuators.
2	Separate the bottom part of the track from the upper track.
3	Clean the areas very well where the bushing guide will slide. BE CAREFUL. There are many sharp edges. Take a small file and remove any burrs that may interfere with the installation of the guides.
4	Apply the silicone grease into the grooves where the guides run.
5	Use caution when reassembling. There are many sharp edges.
6	Before reinstalling the cables to the track, make sure that the tracks are evenly adjusted all the way forward, and all the way down. This will make reinstallation much easier.

IMPORTANT NOTE ABOUT THE POWER SEAT SYSTEM:

This power seat system is an antique. It is not an amusement park ride. It was NEVER designed for continuous use. Continuous use will lock or break the transmission. Move it to the position you like and leave it there. Do not repeatedly hit the end of the track going forward and backward, and up and down. Unlike modern seats that have current sensing, limit switches, and constant position monitoring, these systems do not even have a rubber cushion at the end of travel.
